
BATTLING AT THE FRONT

FIRST PODIUM FOR KM99

We finished this legendary race in 2nd place, achieving our first podium in just two years of existence. This result is a source of immense pride for the entire team and rewards the hard work we have put in since our inception.

FINAL RESULT AND CHAMPIONSHIP STANDINGS

In summary, we finished the race in P2, as the top private team, the best Yamaha, and the leading bike equipped with Dunlop tires. This podium marks a significant milestone for our young team.

In the overall championship standings, we secured 4th place, finishing as the top private team behind three factory teams.
